<p>Dates</p>	<p>Position</p> <p>1.1. <u>Horse Carriages</u></p> <p>Since 1986, I own and operate professionally horse drawn carriages in the city of Bruges (BEL). https://koets.sightseeingbrugge.com/en/home-en</p> <p>For that purpose, I have ca. 25 horses permanently at my disposition. Around ten people, organize my stables. I am the President and spokesperson of the ‘Brugse Koetsiers Ltd,’ a nonprofit interest group for horse driving with tourist sight-seeing in the historical center of Bruges, recognized UNESCO World Heritage.</p> <p>The sector operates 13 licensed horse carriages and 3 horse trams. The 5 owners stable ca. 75 carriage horses and we employ almost 40 persons full time per year. We transport around 350.000 tourists annually in our city. Our format is accepted and recognized as an example for horse welfare for working horses. My stable is also labelled as an official shelter for horses by the Flemish Government – Department Animal Welfare. The only one in the Province of West-Flanders.</p> <p>1.2 <u>Hippo Revue</u></p> <p>Professionally I am the founder, publisher, and the Sr. editor of Hippo Revue, Belgians leading equestrian magazine. I started this glossy horse magazine 35 years ago. This bimonthly publication is edited in a circulation of 18.000 copies and covers all FEI equestrian disciplines. I am well informed about all disciplines,. www.hippo.be</p> <p>1.3 <u>Communication</u></p> <p>One of my other passions is communication.
