MOTIVATION AND VISION
Motivation for serving at EEF I am submitting my candidacy for the EEF Board in order to contribute to the development of the European equestrian community, in which national federations of different sizes and levels of resources can fully influence the future of our sport. My work in various positions within the Ukrainian Equestrian Federation since 2018, as well as my experience as a team chef d'équipe, amateur athlete and horse owner, have given me an understanding of the practical needs of federations, athletes and their support teams. It is especially important to me to represent in Board discussions the perspective of smaller federations and federations working with limited resources. Their challenges should be taken into account when priorities are being set, not only after decisions have been made. Representing Ukraine, I am also particularly aware of the importance of solidarity and maintaining sporting connections in difficult circumstances. If elected, I will seek to listen to other federations, constructively raise shared issues and help ensure that their needs are taken into account in the common work of the EEF. My goal is to make a contribution that goes beyond the interests of my own federation, supporting cooperation for the benefit of the entire European equestrian community.

Vision for the EEF:

I see the EEF as an organisation that combines high sporting standards with broader opportunities for participation and development. Its strength should lie in bringing federations together, understanding the different conditions in which they operate and turning dialogue into practical cooperation.

Balanced participation. I will support regular dialogue with smaller and developing federations so that differences in resources, infrastructure and access to international sport are taken into account in the EEF's priorities.

Practical cooperation. I will promote the exchange of experience between federations and accessible learning opportunities for coaches and officials. Knowledge sharing and regional partnerships can help federations make more effective use of the resources already available.

Opportunities for the next generation. I will support initiatives that help young athletes gain experience and gradually progress to the international level, with attention to the obstacles faced by less-resourced federations.

Trust and responsibility. Horse welfare, fair competition and transparent governance should be the foundation of this work. As a Board member, I will work with colleagues on realistic priorities within the EEF's mandate and available resources, focusing on their practical benefit for member federations.

I began competing in jumping at national level as an amateur athlete in 2010, and from 2012 to 2021 I participated in international competitions as an amateur. I am also a horse owner. Since 2018, I have served as chef d'équipe of the Ukrainian national jumping teams, working with athletes in different age categories. This experience, together with my work in the federation's governing bodies, has given me an understanding of the practical needs of athletes, horse owners and support teams.
